Governor Huntsman proclaims April 6th
BIZWORLD DAY
in honor of the youth financial education program

SALT LAKE CITY, March 27, 2006

Governor Huntsman will sign a proclamation on Thursday, March 30th, 1:00 pm proclaiming April 6th as BizWorld Day in honor of the foundation dedicated to providing money management and entrepreneurship education for youth.

BizWorld students will be on hand to present the Governor with a gift, a friendship bracelet from a recent Bizworld project at a Magna elementary school, and perform a special live presentation of their Bizworld commercials, presented during their Sales Bazaar Day.

Bizworld Utah is a chapter of the BizWorld Foundation, a national non-profit organization that provides financial education programs for youth. BizWorld programs add relevancy to academics, by providing a real world context for their studies.

“[BizWorld] provides our students an opportunity to develop critical communication skills,” said Joey Foote, principal of Greenwood Elementary School, American Fork, and President of the Utah Association of Elementary School Principals, “students are provided the opportunity to identify and work through real problems. At my first introduction to the BizWorld, I immediately saw the development of these aptitudes as a central function of the experience in my school.”
